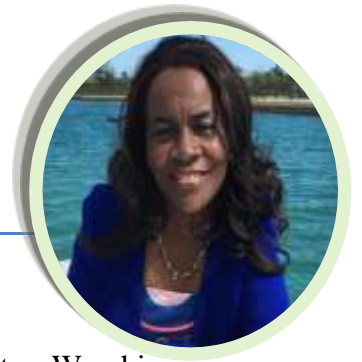


Dr. Agnes Adderley-Glinton - Biography

PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

Dr. Agnes Adderley-Glinton is an Apostle, Prophet, Teacher, Evangelist, Pastor, Worship Leader; Nation Builder; Health, Wealth and Life Coach; Entrepreneur; former Prison Reform Commissioner, and Justice of the Peace. Dr. Glinton is a student of the Word with the Philosophy that learning is a continuing life career.

Dr. Agnes Adderley-Glinton was born on the picturesque island of Long Island in the Commonwealth of the Bahamas, to Malachi and Edith Adderley (both deceased). She was raised in a Christian home where strong godly principals were taught and emphasized.

Her early education began at the Eastern Junior and Senior schools. Under the heavy discipline of Donald W. Davis and other strong disciplinary teachers, she obtained twelve (12) high grades Bahamas Junior Certificates. This opened the door for employment and immediately by was hired by Island Builders Construction Company with responsibilities for office management and Payroll. She also attended Typing classes and Office procedures at Mrs Gordon Typing School.

With an appetite for higher academic achievement, she continued evening classes with Dr. T. B. Donaldson, Mrs. Hilda Barrett and Hon. Livingston Coakley where she obtained three (4) GCE Ordinary Level certificates, in Mathematics, English, Religious Knowledge and Health Science.

On January 1st, 1977, Dr. Glinton committed to her life to the Savior and immediately attended the Assemblies of God Bible College, which authenticates her ability to be used by Father Yahweh in a meaningful way to minister through Church activities, in the prison and behind drug infested areas, and also assist in ushering in a government that is accountable to the 'Preamble of the Constitution' and the moral obligation to promote the principles stated therein.
