Dr. Hamilton continues to lend insight to national development and advocacy through his leadership engagement in various local and international civil society organizations. His professional experience in Business Management and Human Resources Management was honed while working as an Office Administrator / Comptroller in the Bahamian Co-operative Industry and as a Management Consultant for a varied selection of private companies.
